

## LRC LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER

The LRC program is designed for students with varying disabilities that only require part time assistance from special education. Students may have difficulty in an academic skill area (reading, written language, math), and/or in behavioral/social skills.

Students placed in the LRC program, may be identified with any category of disability as defined in the IDEA. Disabilities may include students with mild mental retardation, mild autism, learning disabilities, emotional disabilities, other health impairment, orthopedic impairment, visually impaired, hearing impaired, etc.

The LRC program is staffed by a certified special education teacher. Occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech therapy, and other related services will be provided based upon individual students' IEPs.

Curriculum will be based on AZ Functional Standards, AZ Academic Standards, and other needs identified through the evaluation and IEP process. Data collection to records student progress and achievement toward IEP goals and objectives will be a shared responsibility of all program staff.

The special education teacher is responsible for determining appropriate teaching methods and material, as well as communicating with parents concerning progress. Required quarterly progress reviews will be completed. The need for home visits and parent training will be determined through the IEP process.

LRC programs are available at all schools.
